He gives away all 10 valentines to friends. How many valentines does Dan have left? Student: 1. Draw to solve and 2. Write a number sentence.	Parent:Go to <u>www.abcya.com</u> . Click on Kindergarten → Letters. Student: Play the game "Spelling Practice."
Student & Parent: Find objects around your house that float and sink. Record in your homework journal 3 objects that float and 3 objects that sink.	Student: Draw a bubble chart (one circle in the middle, four circles around). Write President in the middle, and provide 4 details that you know about the president.	Discussion Ask your child his/her opinion about Valentines Day. See if s/he can tell an opinion and give 3 reasons why.
