Student: 1. Draw to solve and 2. Write a number sentence.	Parent: Go to www.youtube.com and search "The Reading Machine 2" Student: Try to read the words along with the video.
Student & Parent: Go to the Library and check out a book about Spring. Read together.	Student: Draw a picture of something living and something non-living.	Parent: Point to various objects in your home. Student: Identify what the object is made of (paper, plastic, glass, wood, metal, fabric, etc).
